Where do I begin?

1

Chose an idea

First up, you need to chose your fundraiser! It can be big or small, silly or sporty, or super simple. Take a look at the ideas on page 6 for inspiration - or get creative and come up with your own brilliant plan.

Pick a date & start planning

Choose a date for your fundraiser and give yourself plenty of time to get ready. Set a fundraising goal and start thinking about what you'll need - helpers, equipment, spaces, and anything else to make your fundraiser shine.



Check the rules & keep costs low

4

Make sure your fundraiser follows school rules and the law (this is especially important for raffles - see page 8 for more details.) Try to keep costs low by asking friends, families, or local businesses to donate items or help out.



5

Spread the word

Let everyone know what's happening! Share the details with students, staff, and families using assemblies, newsletters, posters, and social media. Tell people what you're doing and when, and how they can support you.



Have fun!

6

You've done all the planning, now it's time for the fun part! Encourage everyone to join in, take photos, and enjoy your fundraiser. Remember, every penny raised, makes a huge difference, and you should be proud of what you've achieved.

The boring but important bits

Fundraising should be fun - but there are a few important things to think about to make sure everything is legal and safe.

Permissions

Make sure your fundraiser is approved by your school and follows school policies. Some activities may also need permission from parents or carers - your teacher can advise you on this.

If you're collecting money outside of school, make sure you check with your local authority first to make sure you have permission.

Rules & Licences

Some fundraising events like raffles and lotteries have strict legal rules about how they're organised and some require licenses. You can find out more at www.gamblingcommission.gov.uk. If your event is open to the public, ensure the venue has Public Liability Insurance.

Safety



Depending on your event, you may need to complete a risk assessment to ensure everyone is safe. Ask your teachers and visit the [Health and Safety Executive](http://www.healthandsafety.gov.uk) website for templates and further guidance.

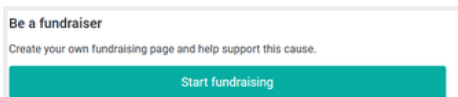

Top Tips

Upload a photo

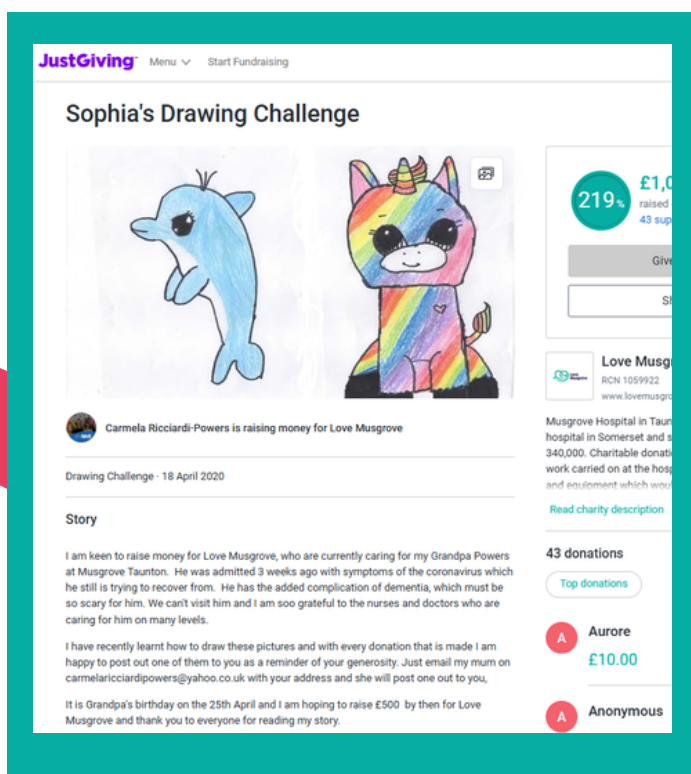
Photos help bring your fundraising page to life and shows people what you're doing. You could upload a picture of your class, or your fundraising activity. Keep adding photos as you go to show your progress. Don't forget to explain why you're fundraising too - sharing your story helps people understand your cause and encourages them to support you.

Set a target

Pages with a fundraising target raise 46% more - so aim high! Setting a target motivates both you and your supporters. And if you reach your goal early, why not increase it?

Share your page

Once your page is ready, it's time to share it far and wide! Share it with family and friends and ask your school community to get involved. The more people who see it, the bigger your impact.



You did it! Now what?

Congratulations - all your hard work has paid off, and you've made a real difference. You should feel incredibly proud of what you've achieved.



Say Thank You

Take a moment to thank everyone who supported your fundraising - donors, volunteers, venues and sponsors. A quick message, a photo from your event, or a social post goes a long way. Your supporters will want to see your amazing achievements!



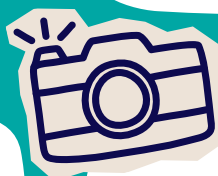
Pay in funds
